Sorry for the headache. [REDACTED] reached out to me indicating she was working with you on funding pursuits for the dam. She had a simple question regarding the cost estimate (whether design engineering and construction engineering were both needed), which I clarified for her. She then asked about the different deficiencies which I responded consistently with the report. I did indicate that the compounding issues of inadequate spillway capacity and slope stability concerns were the driving risk factors (also consistent with the report). I never indicated that addressing the slope stability alone was sufficient. It was a brief conversation.
